Or place you in the right school for your grade.

Your school has to tell Manson that you're back.

And then Manson has to send the school your records and transcripts within 10 days.

You get credit for all your school work at Manson.

You don't need your parent's or guardian's signature to get your records transferred.

The school cannot expel you or punish you for the offense you already served time for.

They can't put you in Alternative Ed unless you say okay.

Life after Manson Going to School in a New Town

For Ages 14 - 17

You Must Enroll.

Call the Board of Education in your town to find out where to bring these documents:

- 1. Your birth certificate
- 2. Your social security number
- 3. Proof that you live in the school district (current utility bill, lease, bank statement)
- 4. Guardianship documents (if you're under age 18)
- 5. Your current IEP (Individual Education Plan) if you have one

The school has to tell Manson that you're enrolled.

And then Manson has to send the school your records and transcripts within 10 days.

You get credit for all your school work at Manson.

You don't need your parent's or guardian's signature to get your records transferred.

The school cannot expel you or punish you for the offense you already served time for.

They can't put you in Alternative Ed unless you say okay.
